If you are in the process of planning extensive home renovations and are interested in making your home more energy efficient, you may



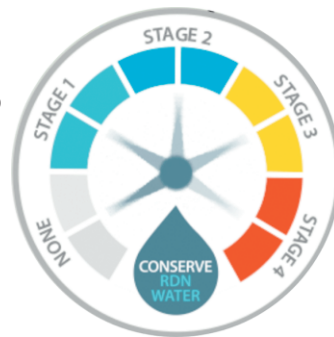

OUTDOOR WATER CONSERVATION

Although we have had a cool and wet start to this summer, water conservation is still important to keep in mind as we head into the warmer summer months. The RDN has recently updated the "Outdoor Water Conservation Levels" for this year.



Some updates include:

- Level 3 now limits watering days to one day per week, with odd-numbered houses on Monday, and even-numbered houses on Thursday
- Level 4 remains the same however, car/boat washing allowed with a shut-off nozzle
- A change in name from "Watering Restrictions" to "Outdoor Water Conservation"

If you are a customer of a municipal, improvement district or RDN water system, please visit www.rdn.bc.ca/watering-restriction-map to see which watering restrictions are in place where you live.

Veggie gardens and drip irrigation are exempt from restrictions.
